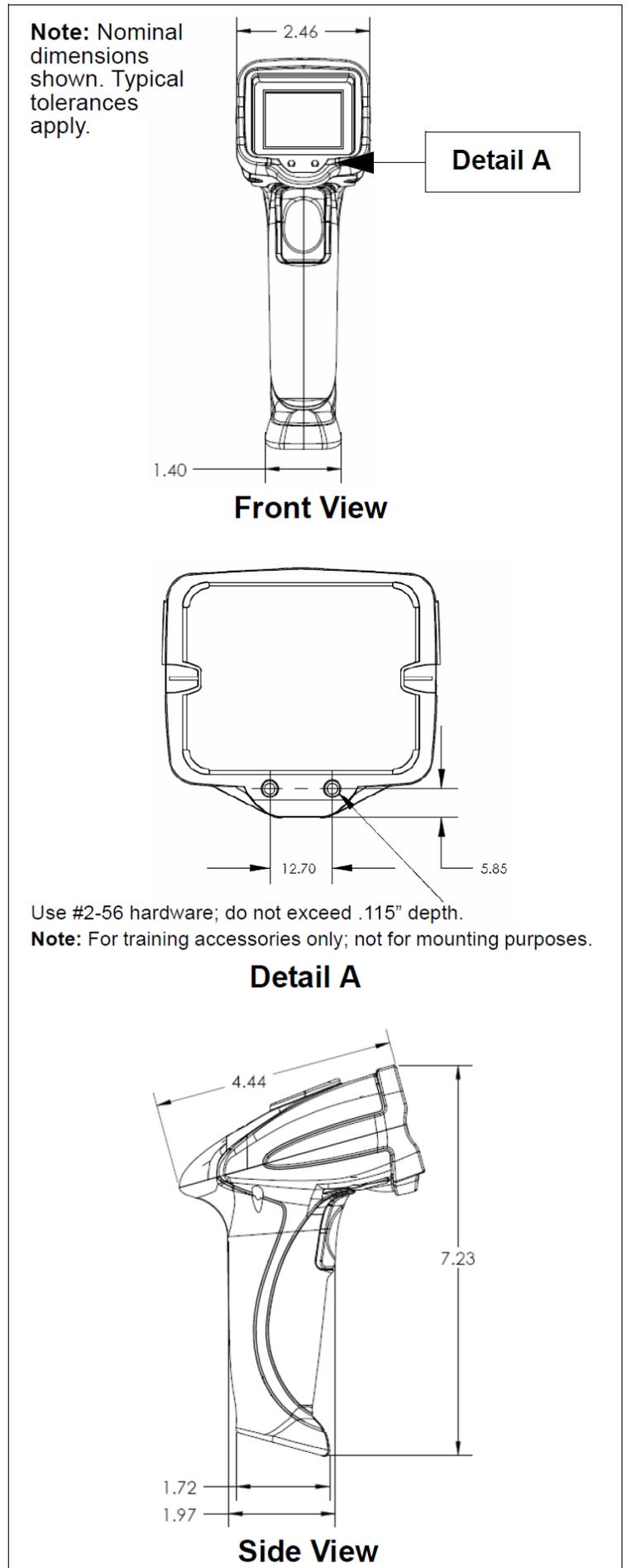

Installation

Connect the hand-held scanner

The USB cable is already installed. If the optional RS-232 cable is used, the cable must be replaced. You have to remove the pull relief for the cable, which is attached with 2 Allen screws.



Switching off the computer

Information on switching off and shut down the connected computer - what ever before to connect peripheral devices such as a scanner is - please refer to the instruction manual of your computer..

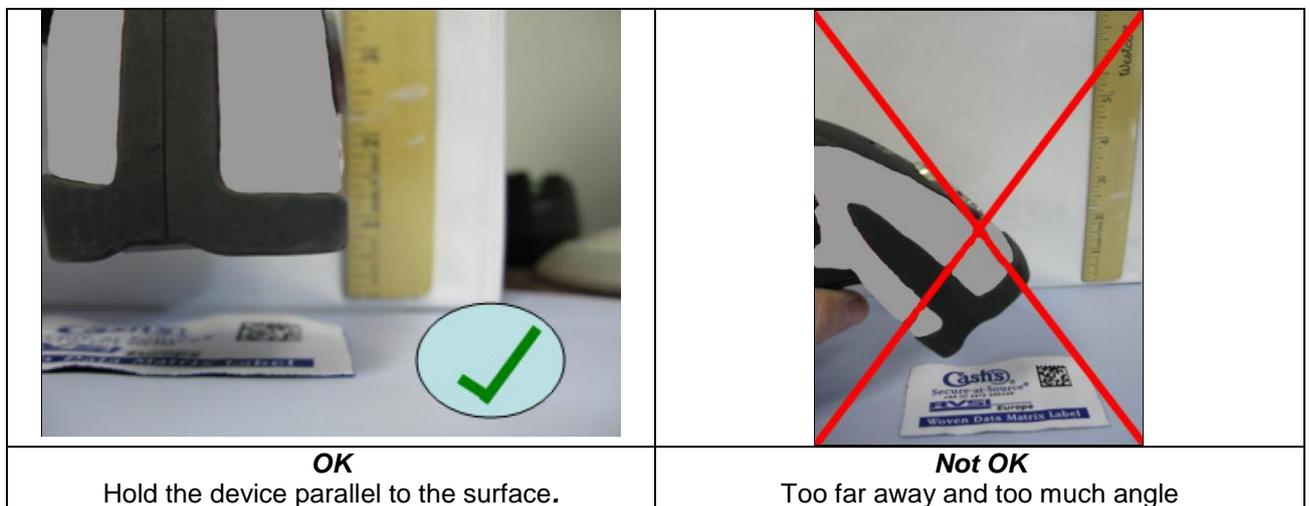
Connect the cable from FIS 6170

1. To fastening the interface cable to the scanner, proceed as follows: Plug the 8 pin connector into the socket on the underside of the hand scanner, you now attach the supplied cable strain relief with the help of an interior hexagonal key.
2. Connect the interface cable to the appropriate socket of the computer.
3. You may need a power supply to the power supply, or you can use a cable in which the tension of the computer system is used. Use the pin assignments (see page 7), you can select the appropriate cable for your application.
4. Plug the AC adapter into the power outlet (if available).
5. Check the operational readiness of the scanner by pointing the scanning surface against a flat surface and pulling the trigger. The lighting should be visible. Now scan a sample label. The scanner confirms with a beep that it is decoded if necessary, the data are transmitted to the computer.

How to scan?

Here are some notes on how to get the best scan performance.

- In the default lighting settings, used the FIS 6170 different setups, which are automatically changed. The 6170 FIS takes on different images with different lighting parameters on to find the optimum settings. If several times the same or the same type of part to be read, it is the last setting made in ascending order to achieve a faster reading
- Keep the FIS quiet 6170 - you do not move the unit. Press the trigger button and hold it until the green LED indicates the reading.
- Keep the FIS 6170 is marked parallel to the front surface, and the code at the center is located. The device is designed to detect without an angle (tilt) of the Code.

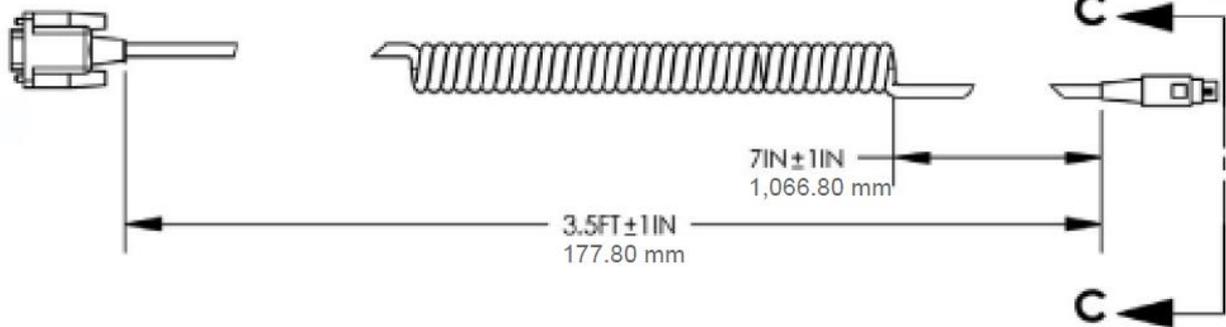

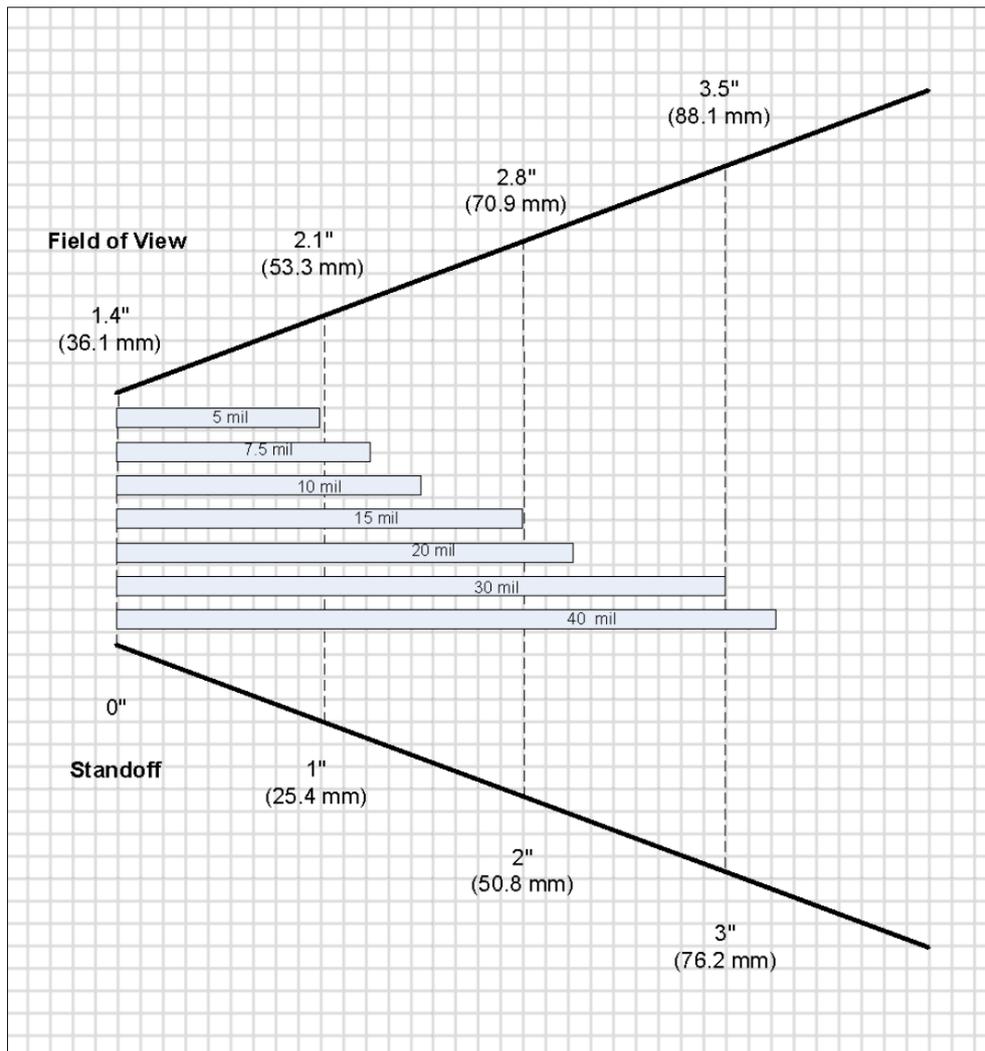

Parameterization

Basically, the hand-held scanner is configured via barcodes. This, first select the bar code is in the manual, and then press the trigger button to read the code. The configuration is then immediately active.

A second option is to configure the hand scanner with USB and RS232 interface using the PC program ESP. This program lets you download and install from our website www.leuze.de. With the program settings can be made and transmitted to the hand-held scanner. The configuration can also be stored, so that later it can be reused.

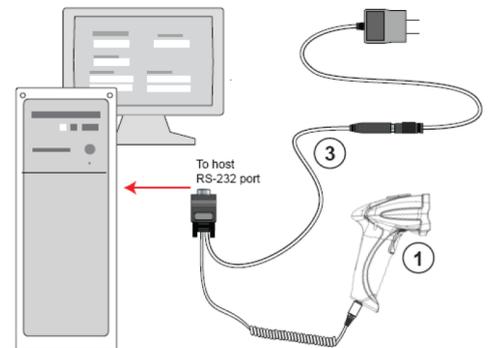

Initial Operation at RS-232

1. Power down the (Host Computer).
2. Connect the cable to the 8-pin mini-DIN connector to the handheld scanner
3. Connect the power supply to the cable
4. Plug the AC adapter into the power outlet and start the PC
5. Start a terminal program on the PC (such as ESP terminal window or HyperTerminal) and set the parameters 57600 baud, 8 data bit, no parity, and 2 stop bits

6. Read the 2D code **Reset to RS-232 Factory Defaults**



7. Read the 2D code **M188_02** to store the parameters permanently.

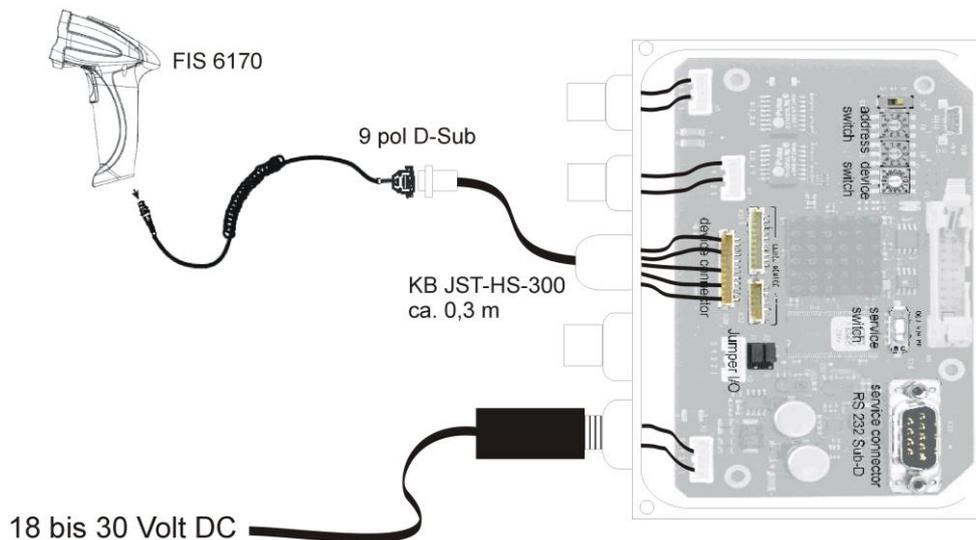

Initial Operation

1. Open the MA 200i
2. Install the KB JST-HS 300 with the high strength cable gland through the threaded hole and connect the 12-pin JST connector plug.
3. Connect the cable to the 8-pin mini-DIN connector to the handheld scanner
4. Connect the 9-pin D-sub connector on the KB JST-HS-300
5. Set on the address selection switch the address
6. Plug in the fieldbus connection cables
7. Connect the Power to the MA 200i
8. Close the MA 200i

FIS 6170 at USB-Interface (COM-Port-Emulation)

The configuration software for the FIS 6170 is on the Leuze electronic software CD.



1. Install the Program ESP.
2. Click on the Icon to start the Program.

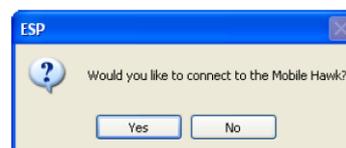


Start of ESP

1. After starting the program ESP, a selection menu for the device model. Select the handheld scanner, FIS 6170'.



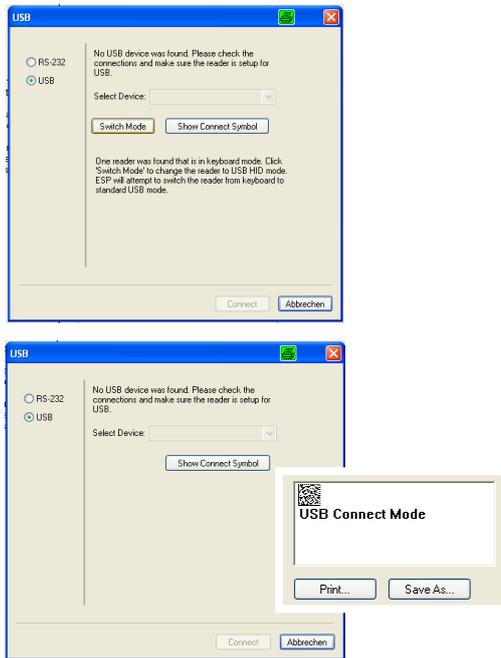

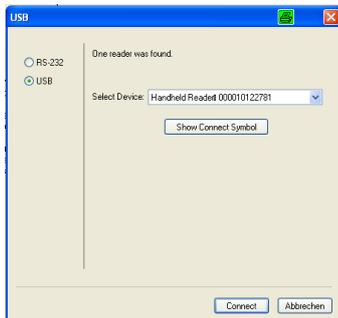
3. Select the type of connection, scan to one when you first connect the default codes for appropriate interface. (See page 11).

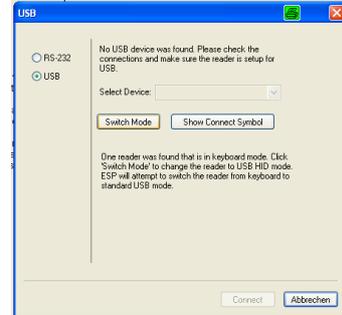

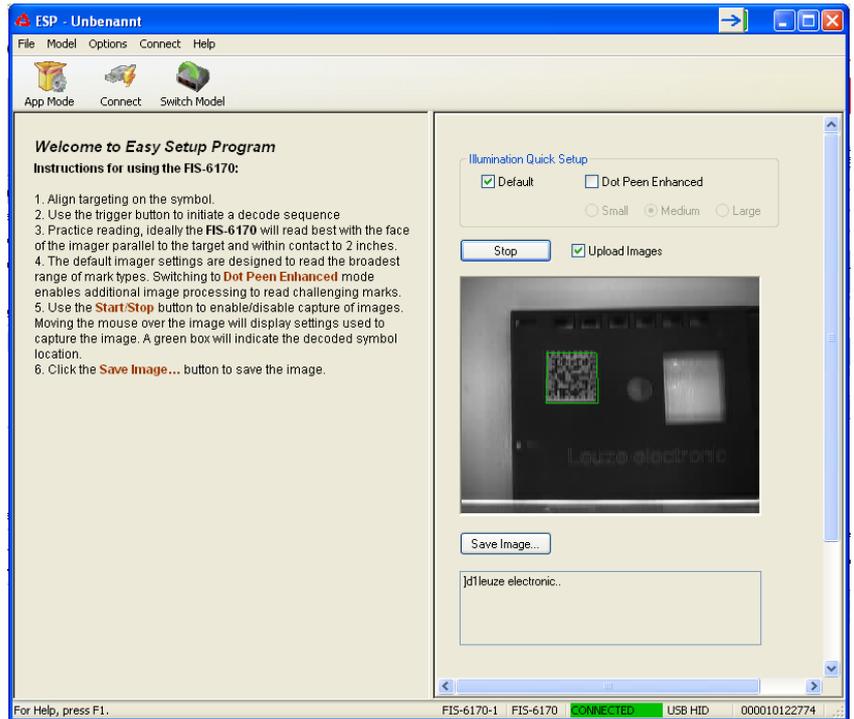

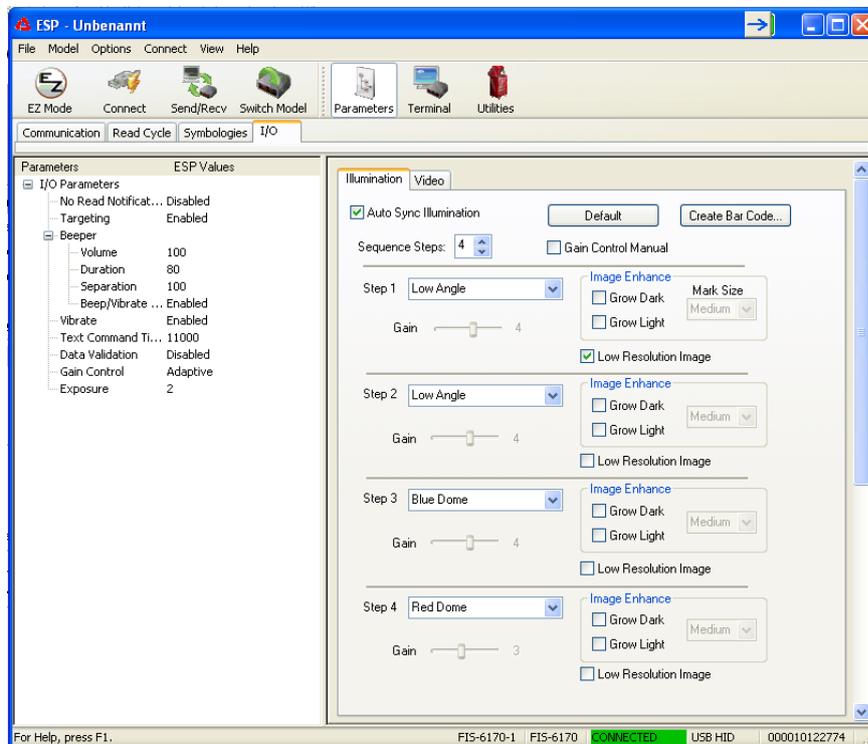

Start the image transfer by clicking on Start, then a code is scanned to see this is after the upload window.



- When you click on App Mode the program change to the Application mode, in this you can setup all Parameters, transfer images and you see the code result in a terminal window.

Troubleshooting

For problem detection and troubleshooting, check your scanner as follows:

1. When the scanner is powered through the interface cable. To do this, scanners and computer be connected before using the scanner with each other, must come up with the computer with a power supply of 5 volts DC for the scanner. Check the manual for your computer, that the power supply to hook up your scanner is sufficient.
2. Make sure that the interface cable is securely attached to the computer. In the manual of the computer for information on proper port on the scanner. Support is also available from your technical staff...
3. If your system operates with an external power supply, make sure that the power adapter is securely connected to the scanner and power supply.
4. Verify that the interface cable is securely attached to the handle of the scanner. To do this, loosen the screws (at FIS 6170) to the end cap of the handle with an appropriate tool. Remove the wire tie and pull out the cable. Run the cable back on again and make sure that it is properly seated in the cradle. Insert the wire tie back and fix everything with screws.
5. If the scanner does not, despite all the measures taken to be ready, replace the power supply with another recommended power supply device from which you know for sure that it is fully functional.
6. Make sure that the interface of your scanner is compatible with the computer. See the manual for your computer. Also check that the scanner is configured for the desired application. This information is described in the User's Guide of the FIS 6170.
7. Verify that the bar code labels that you want to scan are of satisfactory quality and that the used bar code symbology is recognized by your scanner. Sample label for review, contact your dealer, you need accurate information to the label details. (Wrinkled, torn or soiled) Damaged bar code labels can cause the scanner only poorly or not the label recognizes. If you suspect the problem is the quality of the label, check the reading readiness in terms of quality with a good label.
8. If the problems are not now be resolved, please contact Leuze electronic.
